The Bread and Butter Thing brings its affordable food service to three new County Durham locations

Food surplus redistribution charity, The Bread and Butter Thing (TBBT) is working with Durham County Council to expand its innovative, sustainable affordable food service across the region with three new hubs opening in March.

TBBT started its County Durham operation in Peterlee last November where it has currently served 862 members, with collective savings totaling £21,500 in its first 14 weeks (November 17th - February 16th).

For just £7.50, TBBT members' shopping bags are filled with a minimum of £35 worth of items made up of quality fresh food and store cupboard staples from supermarkets.
